

Your medical and prescription drug benefits are administered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota (Blue Cross). Prime Therapeutics (Prime) is trusted by Blue Cross to manage your pharmacy benefits.

To receive medical and pharmacy services, always show your current ID card to both your pharmacy and medical providers. Please read this letter to learn about some key features of your prescription drug benefit.

Prescription drug list — KeyRx Drug List

Many prescriptions will be covered under your Blue Cross plan, if they are included in the KeyRx drug list. If your drug is not listed in the KeyRx drug list, it is not covered. To see drug costs online and price out your medicines, use the pricing tool at **MyPrime.com**.

Pharmacy network — Select Pharmacy Network

Many nationwide pharmacies participate in the Select Pharmacy Network. When you log into the site, you can use the Find a Pharmacy Tool to find the location of your choice. Visit **bluecrossmn.com/agcs** and select "Find a Pharmacy" under Prescription Drugs. Choose the "Select" Network to view pharmacies.

MedsYourWay - Retail and Home Delivery

With MedsYourWay you'll automatically get the lowest price available on prescription drugs. MedsYourWay compares drug card discount prices and your health plan pharmacy benefit to automatically deliver the lowest price to you. No discount card is required, simply show your member ID card at your preferred in-network pharmacy. Any costs you pay for your covered prescriptions (copays, deductible, and/or coinsurance) applies to your out-of-pocket maximum. If you prefer a more convenient option, you can use the MedsYourWay program through Amazon Home Delivery. Covered medications filled through Amazon Pharmacy are shipped to your home free of charge. To get started using the program through Amazon Home Delivery, visit amazon.com/bluecrossmnMYW.

Specialty prescriptions

Specialty medicines for complex illnesses generally cost more and require extra support. If you use a manufacture coupon, only the amount you pay out-of-pocket for specialty drugs will be applied to your deductible/out-of-pocket maximum/limits. If you are enrolled in a non-HSA benefit plan, your copay may even be less if you are enrolled in the FlexAccess Program. The FlexAccess program is designed to help both you and the plan save money on certain specialty medications by obtaining copay assistance (coupons) from drug manufacturers when available. Utilization management programs

Your prescription drug plan includes prior authorization, step therapy and dispensing limits programs to help make sure medicines are used safely and cost effectively. Drugs that fall into one of these programs are listed on your KeyRx Drug List.

- Prior authorization: The prior authorization program is designed to encourage safe, cost-effective medicine use. Under this program, your doctor will need to get an approval from Blue Cross for certain drugs to be covered.
- **Step therapy:** The step therapy program is used to encourage safe and cost-effective medicine use. Under this program, a "step" approach is required to receive coverage for certain high-cost medicines. This means that a medicine will not be covered unless you try another lower-cost medicine first.
- Dispensing limits: Dispensing limits (also called quantity limits) may be applied on select medicines. These limits help promote drug safety, and help reduce waste and overuse. Limits may involve the amount of covered medicine per prescription or the amount of covered medicine in a given time period. If your doctor prescribes an amount that is more than the dispensing limit, they may request a dispensing limit authorization from Blue Cross for approval consideration.

Preventative Drug Coverage

Your benefit also includes a preventive drug list, which provides plan coverage before deductible for preventive drugs which are included on the KeyRx Preventive Drug List. You can find details about preventive drug coverage by accessing the KeyRx Preventive Drug List at **bluecrossmn.com/agcs** (under Prescription Drugs).
