Get the most from your health plan with this handy checklist.

Log in to your member website

Find out if a prior authorization is required

- Ask your doctor or visit bluecrossmn.com/PriorAuth
- You'll need your group number from your member ID card and the procedure code from your doctor

Choose an in-network provider

- Log in to your member website
- Select "Find Care" and then "Search in Network"
- Enter the facility or healthcare provider's name in the search field

Check your plan's drug list (formulary) to make sure necessary drugs are covered

- Click "Benefits" and then "Browse All"
- Click on your prescription drug plan and then select the Click to Access button to be directed to your pharmacy benefit manager
- If a drug is not covered, talk with your doctor. They may be able to prescribe another option.

Choose an in-network pharmacy

- Click "Benefits" and then "Browse All"
- Click on your prescription drug plan and then select the Click to Access button to be directed to your pharmacy benefit manager
